The Ministry of Fisheries and Marine Resources Development (MFMRD) now invites eligible individuals (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services (attach curriculum vitae with description of experience in similar assignments, similar conditions, etc.).

The criteria for selecting the Consultant are as follows:

- Relevant degree (post-graduate) in environmental assessment, social management, development studies and similar equivalent qualification.
- Experience in developing and implementing communications programs and safeguards frameworks.
- Experience with donor-funded projects, especially projects involving international financial institutions such as the World Bank and ADB.

- **Applications must include 3 parts with the following format and content:**

1. A brief covering letter introducing yourself and explaining why you are interested in this post (maximum 1 page).
2. A resume (CV) showing personal details, work experience, and education, along with the names of three work related references (maximum 3 pages).
3. A claim for the position (with each essential and desirable criterion as a sub-heading as in the TOR) that addresses how your experience is applicable to each criterion and providing examples relevant to the post's key tasks and responsibilities (maximum 4 pages).

**Contract duration.**

- The contracts for the above position will be for an initial period of one year, and may be extended for up to 7 months (end of June 2026), subject to satisfactory performance.
